From the Pastor's Desk....

After Christ's death and resurrection, He commanded the disciples to share the Gospel, the message of His redemption in Matthew 28:19-20.



This Great Commission applies to Christians today. Rather than a burden, obeying His call brings joy and reward in heaven. We should fulfill our mission not out of duty but because of love. INDONESIA

WORSHIP

Let everything that has breath praise the Lord is a powerful verse found in Ps.105:6 that spoke volumes

to us during our recent trip to Jakarta in August 2014. As our passion is to share Christ in as many nations as possible in the 10/40 Window, we give all glory to God for opening up the nation of Indonesia. We thank God for our new mission partner, who took care of us very well. Ps. Aris Tarlgan and his wife Ps. Hoslanna hosted us with their kind Indonesian hospitality. Ps.



Aris is the Assistant Bishop of Gereja Kristen Kudus Indonesia (GKKI) that comprises of churches in over 20 provinces in the whole of Indonesia.



We saw several age groups of people who understood the passion and importance of praising God in all situations. The first was the 3 days we spent in Puncak Bogor, ministering to

pastors and leaders at the Jakarta conference. The Harvest Institute of Leadership Training (HILT) was where we spoke at and began to inspire pastors to continue to persevere in



the ministry and to run the race that God has set for them. We praise God that as hands were raised to worship our Lord God Almighty, God deposited new and fresh revelation into them.



Back in Jakarta city, we saw youths who began to praise and worship God with everything within them at a youth service held at Ps. Aris and Ps. Hosianna's church. We spoke to them about developing a walking-talking relationship with God and allowing Him to direct every area of their lives. Being youths, we spoke on the importance of mixing with people who have a positive influence on them.

What touched us the most during this mission trip was our visit to Semper, North Jakarta, which is a slum area about 20 minutes away from the city. This is one of the first ministries started by Ps. Aris and Ps.

Hosianna many years ago. Despite their simple lives and limited resources, these people pralse God with such fervor for every blessing that they have in their lives. We preached and ministered at their cell meeting on Sunday evening and on Monday morning we returned again to visit the kindergarten that they set up to reach out to believers and unbelievers alike. There was such joy in the faces of all the children whom we met. We taught them some action songs and handed out snacks to the children as their parents looked on from the outside. This kindergarten will be a powerful tool for preparing young minds to rise up in the days to come.





On Sunday morning as we ministered in 2 different churches. The one thing that impacted us about Indonesia, was the power of prayer and praise. Many blessings have come into this nation because of Christians who stand in the gap and pray for God's favour. As a result many unbelievers are accepting Christ on a daily basis and churches

are growing by leaps and bounds. We thank God for opening the door for us to step into this nation and be a blessing to them.

The bible is clear in 2 Timothy 3:16-17 that says, "All Scripture is God-breathed, and is profitable for

As such we found that our purpose for this year's mission trip to Myanmar was to instill the Word of God in the lives of bible students who are currently being trained to be become the future generation of pastors, teachers and evangelists. We thank God that during this trip, 3 of our volunteers were able to join us, namely Anita, her son Luke and Han Wei. The 6 of us spent 5 days in Yangon reaching out to students at Church On The Rock, Yangon Grace Bible School and Victory Missions Network which is all located in Yangon and the surrounding villages.



At Yangon Grace Bible School, where we have been regularly ministering in for the past 6 years, we were happy to



see a new batch of 40 over students leave their homes in the rural areas to come and spend 4 years growing in ministry in order to return back and plant more churches. Many of those who have already graduated have planted several churches in the villages and are bringing souls to Christ. We are blessed to have been part of sowing into their lives and raising up future missionaries for the land of Myanmar where there is so much more work to be done.

At Church On The Rock, which is under the leadership of Pastor James Lian Sai, we did a series of 10 topics to inspire them to discover God's plan in their life and their specific call in ministry. Close to 100 students attended this program and many were brought to their knees to answer the call of God in their lives. It was wonderful to see the volunteers in our team reach out and minister to them as they shared the Word and opened up even on personal experiences in their own lives that have brought them to where they are. The testimonies inspired many to push forward for Christ. It was amazing to see these young students re-dedicate their lives to God and take steps of faith to walk the path God has paved for them. Being theologically equipped and given practical exposure, they are destined for a great future.



At Victory Missions Network, we thank God for opening new doors and connecting us to Ps. John Sung. We were able



to minister at their service, conduct a youth conference and run a pastors and leaders training seminar. What truly amazed us at this church was the fervor and passion of the young children at Ps. John's church. The level of intensity when it comes to prayer and a love for the Word, is what struck us the most. This entire mission

trip was also opportunity for us as a team to grow closer, and see our young volunteers grow mature in the call God has

placed upon their lives. To God Be The Glory for every life that was touched and for our team members who have started to mature in their walk with God.

WORK

Many people who are homeless often feel isolated, unloved and have lack of self confidence.

They sometimes even find it difficult to open up and ask for help. This is why it takes time to develop a trusting relationship with them and give them the space to open up and share their struggles. In March 2012, as HOPE Street Ministry began we took to the streets of Kuala Lumpur reaching out to all the homeless people by sharing Christ love and blessing them with food. After



two years of operating from an open car park, we found that many of them were eager to know more about Jesus and be ministered through His Word.



In February 2014, by God's grace we found a rented premises and all the homeless people were invited to come and join us for two hours of worship, preaching of the Word, prayer and ministering. This included a meal and a range of support services. Ever since we began, we thank and praise God that we have a constant attendance of about 50 homeless people who gather to grow into a deeper relationship with Jesus. They enjoy worshipping God, hearing the Word and being ministered through drama, dance and most of all the love.

We have several organizations who have come forward to do their part in reaching out to the homeless by providing free medical check up, eye check, free spectacles from opticians and even haircuts from professional hairstylists. Our aim is

to help the homeless people feel, loved, valued and have a sense of belonging. All of us are blessed to be His hands and feet to bring Christ to them. In an enclosed place, it gives us more time to minister to them individually and as a result of this, we have become family. Some are homeless and others have menial jobs



but have been abandoned by their families due to past mistakes or problems involving the family. We have also begun bible classes with those who have an eagerness to learn the Word.





At the end of the day, what brings me the greatest joy is to see the smiles on their faces. They now have a place where they can belong. Many have testified that they truly feel the love of Jesus each time they step in and more are now starting to open up and share their problems as we look at ways of helping them get back on their feet. What matters most to me is to pour HOPE into them that they may discover

that the only answer to life is JESUS! We give God all glory as many have stood alongside us to see this become a reality.

MALAYSIA

the existence of spirits in objects and the worship of nature.

WORK

rang Asli (meaning original people or aboriginal people) is a generic Malaysian term officially used to describe the indigenous people who live in Peninsular Malaysia. Officially there are 18 Orang Asli tribes each with their own language and custom. There are close to 150 000 of them who live here in Malaysia. As they live in the remote forest, most of them are into rubber tapping, fishing and cutting trees. Sadly the poverty rate stands at 77%. Traditionally these people are animist whereby they believe in





After many years of praying and seeking God, in November 2013, God opened a door and blessed

One Voice Ministries with an Orang Asli village in Pahang that we could adopt. The village consists of 30 families with each household having an average of 5 members. Of the 30 families, only 3 have come to accept Christ thus far. This was 12 years ago and ever since then, missionaries have rarely come to the village. When One Voice stepped in, God gave us one goal and that is to see the entire village saved. The community centre that was built 12 years was left abandoned and much work had to be done to refurbish the place. To date the place is 70% refurbished and we have now set up a church

in the village where people can come to worship every Sunday. The name of the church is GEREJA KASIH KARUNIA TUHAN (GRACE OF GOD CHURCH)

Considering that most of them are illiterate, "oral teaching" is the mode of operation we use in evangelism. This village is made up of the Jakun community and ever since November 2013, we have been able to develop a trusting relationship with the adults and children. Our sole purpose is to share the love of Jesus and help them stand strong in all adversities that they may face. Each time we visit the village, we give them an experience of worship, sharing of the word with pictures, dramas and movies. We also make it a point to help them with groceries, clothes and other basic needs. We realize that there is a lot of work to be done to see the village saved and serving Christ. As we pour God's Word into the adults and children, we envision the future generation



being sold out for Christ and the ability to raise up pastors and leaders to continue what has just begun. It may be long journey, but it is surely one that we truly enjoy and wait in anticipation to see the fruits.

Revelation 7:9 speaks of a great multitude from every nation, tribe, people and language standing before the throne of the Lamb. Our desire is to see the Jakun community in that group...because that is God's ultimate plan.





PHILIPPINES

On Oct 15th 2013, the island of Bohol was hit by a 7.2 magnitude earthquake and barely a month later

It was hit by yet another natural disaster in the form of **Typhoon Halyan**. The destruction that occurred due to the earthquake and the winds of up to 315km/h affected the lives of millions of people. Although more than half a year had already passed, yet during our visit in June 2014, we found that many people were still picking up the pieces of their shattered lives and

homes. The world may have forgotten about it but for many of them, it is still fresh in their memories.





Houses can be built and food can be distributed but what about the hearts of those broken due to the lost of their loved ones? This was the whole purpose of our 11 day mission trip to Bohol and Cebu. We moved from one province to another to visit all the areas affected such as Tagbilaran, Cebu City, San Isidro and Kawit. We conducted seminars in churches to encourage the people and build hope back into their lives.





It was truly an eye opening experience for us as we visited these places and spoke to those affected at ground zero. What amazed us most of all was that in every church that we stepped into, we found people who have not given up hope or lost their trust in Jesus. Despite facing two catastrophes of epic

proportion, they still continue to worship Him passionately in the midst of their daily struggles.

It makes us realize that some of the struggles that we face is nothing compared to what they are currently dealing with. How thankful we should be to God that He enables us to face the adversities that may hit us. His grace is sufficient in all things. We thank God that we were found worthy to be used as His vessels to encourage and uplift the spirits of those in these Islands and give them a hope for the future.

This mission trip was very much different from all the previous ones as we got to see first hand the effects of such a disaster. The people have proven their faith and trust in God amidst grief and misery, as such earning the praises of the world.

In the month of August 2014, One Voice headed to

Phnom Penh, Cambodia for a mission trip. This was our second trip to the nation of Cambodia. It was at the invitation of our mission partner there, Pastor Sammy Lamanilao. Ps. Sammy and his wife Ps. Merlyn are missionaries from Philippines who are committed to bullding the kingdom of God in Cambodia. We were the speakers at the National Youth Conference that saw around 120 youths gather together from the



various provinces in Cambodia. Many among them were unbelievers who had a desire to grow in the Lord and know more about our Saviour.



The theme of the camp was "Faithful To The End". The sessions were tallored to encourage the younger generation to heed the clarion call of evangelism and making a difference in the lives of people. Stories about renowned men and women who attempted great things for God were shared to inspire the young minds. Since Cambodia sits in the 10/40 Window, there was a session to bring knowledge on the area. Being youths we also touched on the pressures that surround the younger generation today and how it can be overcome, with God. We spoke to them about reflecting Christ among their friends and being the salt and light to them, that they may know the One True God.

One of the highlights of the camp was a session that was held for the unbelievers for the purpose of evangelism. many of them accepted Jesus as their personal Lord and Saviour. Seven of those who accepted the Lord were those who have been seeking Him ever since they got connected to the church, by God's divine intervention. They had been attending church regularly and growing in the faith with their other Christian friends. We were blessed to have been able to witness their water baptism and officially welcome them to the family of God. The smiles on their faces expressed their intense joy of having found true peace and love in Jesus.





We also realized the importance of sharing Christ not just in the church circle but also in the business world. As such we were invited to share on Biblical Principles for a successful Business at the Rajana Association located in the center of Phnom Penh city. This business is run by Christians who desire to make resources and sow it into God's Kingdom.

Our experience during this recent trip to the nation of Cambodia, was meaningful to us in more ways than one. It made us realize that there are many out there who are seeking for answers in life, not knowing that JESUS is the only answer. It takes people like all of us who will rise up, step out and share that message. The opportunities of reaching people who have yet to know JESUS are limitless if only we avail ourselves. In the hands of a living God, we can be useful as vessels of honour.





Jerico has a sincere love for the street people and all those whom we reach out to in ministry. Abang Sulong and Kak Sainah are Orang Asli from our village in Pahang. Of the 30 families that live there, their family is one of the 3 who accepted Christ many years ago. The village did not have much Christian work in the past 15 years but has since been revived beginning January this year. Their entire family is saved from animist beliefs to now being active Christians. They attend service every Sunday and we are slowly equipping them in the Word to lead the village to a deeper knowledge of Christ.



Keziah Lamanilao, is from Cambodia. Her parents are Filipinos who have been missionaries in the land of Cambodia for the past 14 years. They are based in Phnom Penh and have an active church that has services in English and Khmer. Keziah, (12 years of age), serves in the children's ministry. Their church also has a program that reaches out to street kids and this is where her passion lies. Keziah is also one of those under our One Voice Ministries Scholarship Program. She is a hardworking yourg girl who like her parents have a heart to serve the Lord. We trust God has great plans for her.



Abang Abas and Kak Noriah is one of the other families in our Orang Asli village who have also accepted Christ and are faithful in attending service on Sundays. Their children are also growing in the Word through our Sunday School. Thanks to the help of some other pastors whom we are working with, a cell group was started and this has helped the families grow. Our prayer is that the Christian families will be a beacon to all the rest that they may in time come to know Jesus as their Lord and Savior.



Timothy and Phoebe are fruits of the Yangon Grace Bible School that we visit and teach at yearly. We met Phoebe several years ago as a student at YGBS. She and her husband have always had a passion for missions. They left the remote village in Tarlay and came to Yangon City to complete their Degree in Theology. Led by God's Spirit, they returned to Tarlay and set up a church in New Bethel Village which we visited and ministered at last year. The work is growing and their heart's desire is to see the whole village saved and worshipping Jesus.

Ephraim Barahan is from the island of Bohol in the Philippines. The Lord touched him at a young age and since then he has always wanted to use his life in service for God. When he heard about the Degree in Theology that was being conducted at Cristal e-College, his heart was drawn to it. It was by God's divine intervention that the college agreed to give him a 50% discount on the course fee and One Voice Ministries Scholarship Program stepped in to cover the remaining cost and living expenses. Ephraim's desire is to be a missionary to the remote islands. He will graduate in March 2016 and will then begin his call as a missionary for the Lord.



Jeffrey Bernales was the first student when our Scholarship program began. He was from Mabini, a small town in the island of Bohol as well. He was passionate about serving Christ and began even as a student at Cristal e-College as he reached out and touched the lives of all the other students whom he met. Every opportunity he could get, he shared the Word with those he met. During his first year of study, Jeffrey suffered a severe asthma attack in the middle of the night and went home to be with the Lord at the tender age of 21. Yet, in that short time, he touched and changed the lives of many people including us.



Jelly Ann Abapo is from the island of Pangapassan which is just off shore the island of Bohol. It is one of the 7107 islands in the Philippines. Her parents pastor the church on the island and having been brought up in ministry, her heart is for the younger generation to be equipped in the Word. Jelly Ann is undertaking the same Degree Program at Cristal e-College and is also under our One Voice Scholarship Program. Her plan upon graduation in March 2016 is to serve in the Children's Ministry and reach out to kids who still lack the knowledge of the Word in the remote areas.



Daniel Thawng Mang comes for the nation of Myanmar. During one of our mission trip to Myanmar, he was one of the students at a Bible School that we were ministering in. Over the years we continued to keep in contact and One Voice helped in part of his expenses for his Masters in Divinity which he pursued in India. Daniel is currently an active missionary reaching out to the people in the remote villages in the Chin state of Myanmar. He is now married to Ngun Zing Mang and has a daughter by the name of Grace.
